

PLANT PASSPORT

INSPECTION

Documentary checks

- The Inspector ask the responsible person to present all record book.
- Record books consists of:
 - The purchases and sales of plants and plant products.
 - Any plant passports from EU countries (due to purchases of cuttings etc).
 - In case of a third country the PHMD signed by the BIP's Inspector.

Documentary checks

- In the case of suppliers document , the variety name . In case of local variety evidence of the seed origin.
- Site Plan of premises;
 - The site plan should be updated every time when there is changes in the nursery layout or any reference which justify these.

Documentary checks

- Site plan shall be available to the inspector to carry out better his duties.
- Records concerning the growing plant.
 - Observations of the quality of material arrived or being grown
 - General crop care
 - Treatments
 - Storage
 - Hygiene

Physical checks of premises

- Equipment used during the propagation cycle
- Hygiene requirements for propagation areas
- Pesticides according to legislation
- Record keeping of maintenance of equipment and cleaning of propagation areas

Phytosanitary checks

- Check any disease outbreaks in previous years.
- Check on propagation material and plants of any harmful organisms.
- Collection of samples for obligatory surveys and also for pests and diseases as laid in the respective legislation.

Report writing

- The inspector after the inspection draws up a report ,and submit a copy to the nurseryman with the necessary recommendations (if necessary) to be observed.
